In the workshop Andrew will discuss the 5 forms of service that are necessary to become a sacred activist, the 7 laws that he has distilled from the worlds mystical traditions that govern the wise use of sacred activism and pay special attention to the 4 kinds of sacred practice that he recommends to all sacred activists to help them build a holistic spiritual container that can be strong enough to withstand the inevitable stresses and pressures. Participants will leave with a comprehensive understanding of what Sacred Activism is and with practical tools to help them in their ordinary lives put it into immediate practice.
